

BCAT seeks Adult Workforce Development Program Director

Buffalo Center for Arts and Technology (BCAT) is seeking a full-time Adult Workforce Development Program Director to administer and direct our Adult Workforce Development Program for adults, ages 21-60. Currently BCAT annually offers 16 adult training classes in allied health, technology and landscape maintenance to over 200 participants. Classes are offered Monday through Friday throughout the day from 9:30am- 8:30pm. This is an on-site position; minimum 40 hours/week. This position will require some evening and weekend hours.

Salary: \$75,000 - \$80,000

Essential responsibilities:

- Direct and monitor all Adult Workforce program operations
- Plan and implement program scheduling, curriculum development, student recruitment and retention and community outreach strategies
- Administer and ensure adherence to program compliance regulations as a proprietary school under NYS DoE
- Manage data, budgets, reports, grants and deliverables
- Maintain compliance and accurate records on recruitment, attendance, retention, and student placement/employment
- Establish and maintain positive working relationships with licensing and accreditation bodies, employers for internship placements and job placement of graduates, other not-for-profits and adult workforce programs, students, community organizations, and the public
- Collaborate with BCAT's development team to identify new funding opportunities and partnerships to support existing programming and establish new classes
- Contribute as a full partner on the BCAT Leadership Team, ensuring that BCAT continues to be a high-functioning organization delivering on its mission.

The right candidate will have:

- Bachelors in related field (education, school administration, educational psychology or human resources); MA preferred
- Minimum 5 years leadership experience in a not-for profit organization
- Proven leadership experience supervising a diverse workforce in a dynamic programmatic setting
- Credentials acceptable to gain BPSS Director license
- Experience developing, implementing and managing processes and procedures
- Ability to manage multiple projects and respond to emerging priorities.
- Demonstrated ability to think analytically, take initiative, and be results-and detail-oriented
