

BCAT seeks IT Instructors

Buffalo Center for Arts and Technology (BCAT) is seeking part-time IT Instructors to teach in-classroom instruction to a maximum of 15 adult students. Topics covered will include Information Technology, Technical Support, hardware/software, internet technology, computer networking concepts, info systems and network/cybersecurity.

Classes offered include IT Fundamentals, A+, Network+ and Security+. Classes meet for Monday - Thursday for 3 hours each night from 5:30pm-8:30pm. BCAT uses a standardized curriculum/syllabus for the technical knowledge and provides support as needed. Instructors are compensated for all teaching hours a week with additional hours of paid prep time each week.

Hours: 2-4 evenings per week, 5:30pm - 8:30pm

Salary: \$45 - \$55/hr

Essential responsibilities:

- Prepare lesson plans and present facilitative, well-prepared, organized, and clear lectures and classroom activities
- Promote students' development of IT skills, communication, professionalism, problem-solving, and decision-making
- Collaborate with team members to support adult learners using multiple adult learning teaching techniques
- Keep class relevant and engaging, incorporating real-world career experiences from both the instructor and students
- Focus on developing and maintaining excellent relationships with a diverse staff and student population

- BA/BS Degree in Computer Science or related field
- AS degree in Computer Science and 2 years of full-time practical experience in Computer Network Administration
- High School Diploma and 5 years of full-time practical experience in Computer Network Administration
- Any current CompTIA Certification, willingness to obtain additional certifications
- Experience instructing adult learners a plus
- Demonstrated proficiency in Microsoft Office and Google Workspace
- Must meet the NYSED teaching credentialing requirements and be willing to obtain NYS teaching license
